



## FROM MANAGING THE PRESENT TO **REHEARSING THE FUTURE**



## GOVERNMENT AS A LIVING LABORATORY

Governments are beginning to prototype functions once considered science fiction:



### Chief Trust Architect

Engineers credibility in an age of deepfakes and declining faith in institutions.



### Minister for the Planetary Commons

Oversees what belongs to all humanity: the oceans, atmosphere, cyberspace, and biodiversity.



### Director of Algorithmic Justice

Ensures AI systems reflect fairness, not bias.



### Chief Imagination Officer

Embeds creativity and foresight in public problem-solving.



### Minister for the Unknown Unknowns

Anticipates black swan events and existential risks.

These titles might sound strange but so did “Minister of the Environment” fifty years ago.

## THE SPECULATIVE CABINET

### **Minister for Post-Work Economies**

Designs meaning and prosperity beyond traditional employment.

### **Sentient Systems Ombudsman**

Arbitrates disputes involving conscious AI.

### **Digital Identity Chancellor**

Guards privacy in a world of verified everything.

### **Cyberspace Peacekeeper**

Mediates cyber conflicts across nations.

### **Commissioner for Existential Risk**

Scans for civilization-level threats.

### **Urban Psychologist**

Applies behavioral science to design cities that nurture well-being.

### **Memory Warden**

Protects truth in an era of synthetic realities.

### **Minister of Reality Integrity**

Defends shared truth against mass disinformation.
